



# CONTEXT

St Edward's Christian Brothers' College was established in 1953 by the Christian Brothers and has provided quality Catholic secondary education for boys over the last 61 years. It is located in an idyllic setting on the foreshores of Caroline Bay and comprises a campus of 7 hectares. St Edward's is a comprehensive high school where the average enrolment is 1040 boys and the total staff, including support staff, is 120. St Edward's is a Christian Brothers College conducted in the traditions of Edmund Rice, and is part of the network of 43 Edmund Rice Education Australia schools which are guided in the pursuit of excellence by the Charter for Edmund Rice Schools. This Charter advocates the four touchstones of: Liberating Education, Gospel Spirituality, Justice and Solidarity and Inclusive Community. These touchstones provide the framework for the strategic directions of St Edward's College into the future. St Edward's has developed facilities of exceptional quality to assist in the educational and spiritual formation of 'Young Men Who Achieve'.

At St Edward's the focus is on holistic education, where learning opportunity is paramount. All members of the community are challenged to focus their learning in the areas of spirituality, pastoral care, sport, leadership, curriculum, and extra-curricular activities. St Edward's aims to strike a desirable balance between the pursuit of academic excellence in all Key Learning Areas and the provision of strong vocational training across a wide range of curriculum offerings. St Edward's has a rich tradition in sport, providing social outreach to those less fortunate, and developing close links to the Central Coast community. St Edward's governance structure includes an advisory College Board, Parents and Friends Association and an Old Boys Association. St Edward's also conducts the Haven Education Centre in Terrigal which provides alternative education to students from all Central Coast schools who are experiencing problems in coping with mainstream education.

St Edward's College community is committed to social justice and service, quality education and individual and community growth, inspired by our Catholic ethos and our Edmund Rice tradition.



Our community is accepting and welcoming, fostering right relationships and committed to the common good.


As a Catholic school in the Edmund Rice tradition throughout 2015-2018 we will:
