Uni opens doors all over the world. Not only will you be exposed to global experiences while studying, many degrees qualify you for jobs around the world.


FEEL PREPARED FOR WORK

4 x 10 week terms	2 x 13 week semester
9am – 3pm 5 days a week, fixed timetable	Varies depending on your own work/life commitments
Classes and include some lab/practical depending on the subject during class	Lectures, tutorials and labs
English, Maths and electives for entire year	4 courses per semester, 8 per year
Teachers mark the roll each class and request notification from parent and guardians if you do not attend	No one is making you attend. Completely the students' responsibility
Teachers will remind and ensure that you hand in assessments and homework	Very much self directed. Students are responsible for preparing for classwork, assessments and studying for exams
Support services provided to the student	Large number of support services available, student required to seek these out

NEWSTEP

Didn't complete year 12 due to adverse circumstances or missed the chance to get the marks you needed for university entry?

Newstep is your second chance and guaranteed pathway to an undergraduate degree.

To be eligible for a place you must be:



from 18 to 20 years of age in the year of study



an Australian citizen or permanent resident currently living in Australia



WHAT IS OPEN FOUNDATION?

Open Foundation is a free pathway program offered at the University of Newcastle for people, 20 years and older, who do not have the qualifications required for direct entry into an undergraduate degree program.

 This may not be relevant to you right now, but if you think uni is not for you now, you still may choose to go to uni later in life.
