- Completed high school studies (minimum year 10 or equivalent) and have sound mathematics and communication skills
- An interest in a trade working within a high voltage electricity transmission network
- A current driver's licence or be willing to obtain one as soon as possible after appointment
- Ability to travel and work away from home at various locations when required
- Ability to start on January 2023
