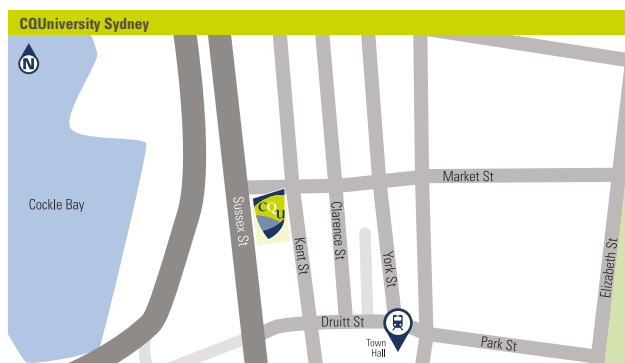
COURSES

BACHELOR OF MEDICAL SONOGRAPHY AND GRADUATE DIPLOMA OF MEDICAL SONOGRAPHY - CG91

Sonographers work with patients using ultrasound imaging technology to diagnose and guide the management of a range of medical conditions. This pioneering course allows you to enter a niche medical profession with no prior degree in health sciences.

Practical learning experiences are central to this course, where you'll complete 2000 hours of clinical placement under the direct supervision of a qualified sonographer. Upon completion of the course, you will be recognised as a high-calibre practitioner fully accredited by the Australian Sonographers Accreditation Registry.

BACHELOR OF ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY (CARDIAC PHYSIOLOGY) AND GRADUATE DIPLOMA OF ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY - CV69

Echocardiographers are highly specialised health professionals that use a range of diagnostic tools, including ultrasound equipment, to produce diagnostic images, video loops, laboratory data and 3D / 4D volumes of cardiovascular anatomy.

This unique course is taught in state-of-the-art, purpose-built environments using the latest in digital technology and simulated learning clinics to examine the anatomy and physiology of the heart. Your learning is supported by clinical supervisors and academic staff to complete 2240 hours of clinical placement.

PRINCIPAL'S RECOMMENDATION SCHEME

If you're a Year 12 student, our Principal's Recommendation Scheme is an early offer scheme that lets you apply to CQU based on the written recommendation of your high school principal rather than an ATAR. Applications for Term 1, 2025, open on Thursday, 1 August 2024, with offers released from Monday, 2 September 2024. Applications for Term 1, 2025 will close Monday, 2 December 2024. SKILLS FOR TERTIARY EDUCATION PREPARATORY STUDIES (STEPS)

STEPS is a free enabling program that can help you gain entry into university. Tailored to you and your unique study goals, STEPS is designed to help you complete prerequisite subjects, satisfy the entry requirements for your chosen degree, or give you the confidence and skills to successfully enter and undertake university study. START UNI NOW (SUN)

SUN is the perfect chance for you to get a taste of your desired course. Students completing Year 10 or studying in years 11 and 12 are eligible to apply. Your first SUN unit is free and if you decide to study further SUN units, they will be heavily subsidised. After successful completion of a SUN unit during your senior high school years, you may be eligible to apply for direct entry into your preferred course (excluding quota managed courses) and receive credit toward your degree. PRINCIPAL'S RECOMMENDATION SCHEME

CQUniversity's Principal's Recommendation Scheme (PRS) provides Year 12 students with an alternate entry pathway to a wide range of CQU courses. Year 12 students can apply for a course and receive an unconditional* offer based on the recommendation of their school Principal, rather than an ATAR.

With entry based on a Principal's recommendation, the PRS recognises that factors such as motivation, talent and passion play an important role in student success at university.

BENEFITS OF THE SCHEME

The Principal's Recommendation Scheme is an ideal entry pathway for all Year 12 students, whether they are on track for an ATAR or not.

The Scheme gives students certainty about their study options after school with entry based on the recommendation of their school Principal, rather than their ATAR result. Plus, with applications opening in August and offers commencing from early September, students can receive an unconditional offer for a CQU course before their senior results are released.

WHAT TO INCLUDE ON THE RECOMMENDATION LETTER

To be accepted, the Principal's recommendation letter must:

- » be on school letterhead
- » be signed and dated by the Principal
- » list the student's full name
- » list the name of the course that the student is being recommended for.

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COURSES WITH ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

CL91 - Bachelor of Nursing

Students will need to complete an additional declaration in relation to English language requirements.

CC14 - Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood)

CC12 - Bachelor of Education (Primary)

CC13 - Bachelor of Education (Secondary)

Students will need to meet prerequisite requirements and non-academic entry requirements. This includes demonstrating the key competencies outlined by the Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL). Conditional offers only will be made for these courses.

CC41 - Diploma of Music

CG51 - Bachelor of Music

CG72 - Bachelor of Theatre

Students will need to meet non-academic entry requirements and complete an audition. Conditional offers only will be made for these courses.

The application process is simple and fast. Students apply direct to CQU and attach their school Principal's recommendation letter with their online application.
