## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### **WHO?**

- Tutors must be in Years 10, 11 or 12.
- Tutees can be in Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12.

### WHAT?

- Tutee must set a SMART goal before starting (this will help Ms Livermore choose the right Tutor for you).
- Tutors will receive training on how to teach another student prior to starting.
